Our undergraduate academic offering includes degrees across six fields in Medicine and Health Sciences.

BSc Dietetics

Trains dietitians to function independently in the areas of therapeutic nutrition, community nutrition and foodservice management.

BSc Physiotherapy

Trains physiotherapists who can work in the health spheres of promotion, prevention, treatment or intervention, and rehabilitation.

Bachelor of Speech-Language & Hearing Therapy

Trains speech-language therapists to help with the management of communication disorders.

Bachelor of Occupational Therapy

Trains occupational therapists to design effective interventions for persons with developmental delays and functional deficits.

MBChB

Produces graduated doctors who are able to function autonomously in the primary health care sector.

Bachelor of Nursing

Trains registered nurses and midwives to work effectively autonomously in the health care sector.
