






## **Disability Unit (DU)**



- We strive towards the full inclusion of students with disabilities.
- We do this by:
  - Making reading material accessible in various formats. To do this we make hardcopy material accessible to people with print disabilities, such as people who are blind and visually impaired;
  - Advising about the most appropriate assistive technologies in liaison with HUMARGA;
  - Liaising with the Centre for Student Communities to ensure that students with disabilities who have mobility and sensory impairments, such as visually impaired people, stay in residences on campus;
  - Liaising with Faculties to ensure innovative individualized academic support for students with specific learning needs;
  - Reviewing test and exam concessions applications;
  - Doing advocacy work that includes workshops for staff and students, including an accredited Lead with Disability workshop for students.


