Dean's Bursaries for Postgraduate Study in Law 2017

Stellenbosch University Law Faculty

The Stellenbosch Law Faculty has a number of bursaries available for fulltime postgraduate study (LLM (Research) and LLD) under its Dean's Bursary Scheme for 2017.

Bursary amounts vary between R60 000 and R90 000 per annum for a period of two years in the case of LLM studies and three years in the case of LLD studies.

Students will be expected to study fulltime and in residence at the Stellenbosch Law Faculty for the duration of their studies.

Candidates wishing to pursue postgraduate studies may apply to the Dean's Office by submitting, in electronic form:

- a full CV,
- full official academic record,
- application letter (containing a motivation for pursuing postgraduate study and the candidate's financial position) and
- a research proposal.

It is advisable for candidates to approach potential supervisors in the Faculty to discuss the proposed study and to indicate such communication in the application letter. Details on the fields of expertise of members of staff can be found on the Faculty's website at www.sun.ac.za/law.

The closing date for applications is 31 May 2016.

Selection of successful applicants will be based on:

- Academic merit during the candidate's undergraduate and where relevant postgraduate studies,
- other relevant achievements as set out in the candidate's CV,
- the motivation for pursuing postgraduate studies as set out in the application letter,
- financial need,
- the merit of the research proposal including any input from potential supervisor(s),
- the available supervision capacity in the Faculty.

Only students from historically disadvantaged communities will be considered under this scheme.
