THE SITUATION

Corruption remains one of the biggest threats to democracy and development on the African continent. As a systemic threat, corruption can only be countered in a networked way. No single entity or single initiative will prevail. In South Africa, the current government has unequivocally committed itself to countering corruption and the government's initiatives are complemented by counter-corruption efforts of many other social actors. The threat, however, remains. It is thus critical for society to come together to galvanise momentum, to confirm broad-based support to those leading counter-corruption efforts and to create a shared platform for eradicating endemic corruption in our society.
