

Call for Bursary Applications 2025:

Chair in Urban Law and Sustainability Governance

Stellenbosch University, Faculty of Law -

The Chair in Urban Law and Sustainability Governance invites expresssion of interest to join the Chair as a full-time Doctoral (LLD) or Masters (LLM) student in 2025.

Applicants are expected to clearly demonstrate interest to help advance the focus of the Chair's research on specific aspects of urban law and sustainability governance relevant in South Africa and other comparable legal jurisdictions.

Succesfull candidates will conduct their studies under the supervision of Prof Anél du Plessis. Postgraduate students in the Chair are residential students (Stellenbosch) and study full-time.

Note: the available bursaries only <u>partially</u> cover costs of study. Unfortunately, no full cost of study / wrap-around bursaries are available.

Minimum requirements:

For LLD studies: An average of 68% or above for the LLM dissertation /

thesis. Published articles would be to the benefit of the

applicant.

For LLM studies: An average of <u>68% or above</u> for the 3rd <u>and</u> 4th year of

LLB study.

- CV (with two academic references listed)
- Copy of ID
- Copy of full academic record
- For <u>LLD</u>: copy of completed / draft LLM dissertation
- For <u>LLM</u>: copy of a completed and authentic written assignment (eg for a LLB module)
- 2 page-memo sufficiently explaining interest in joining this specific Chair.

Shortlisted applicants may be invited for a virtual interview.
