Our undergraduate academic offering includes degrees across six fields in Medicine and Health Sciences:

BSc Dietetics

Trains dietitians to function independently in the areas of therapeutic nutrition, community nutrition and foodservice management.

BSc Physiotherapy

Trains physiotherapists who can work in the health spheres of promotion, prevention, treatment or intervention, and rehabilitation.

Bachelor of Speech-Language & Hearing Therapy

Trains speech-language therapists to help with the management of communication disorders.

Bachelor of Occupational Therapy

Trains occupational therapists to design effective interventions for persons with developmental delays and functional deficits.

MBChB (Medicine)

Trains future doctors who are able to function autonomously in the primary health care sector.

Bachelor of Nursing

Trains registered nurses and midwives to work effectively autonomously in the health care sector.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BSc Dietetics

35 candidates are selected annually.

- An average of at least 60%
- Mathematics 50%
- Physical Sciences 50%
- Life Sciences 50%

Duration:

4 yr. academic
1 yr. community service

Bachelor of Speech-Language & Hearing Therapy

30 candidates are selected annually.

- An average of at least 60%
- Physical Sciences OR Life Sciences 50%
- At least TWO of the following THREE languages (Home Language or First Additional Language) 60%: English AND/OR Afrikaans AND/OR a third South African language.
- Mathematics 50% or Mathematics literacy 80%

Duration:

4 yr. academic
1 yr. community service

MBChB (Medicine)

280 candidates are selected annually.

- An average of at least 75%
- Mathematics 60%
- Physical Sciences 50%
- Life Sciences 50%

Duration:

6 yr. academic,
2 yr. internship,
1 yr. community service

BSc Physiotherapy

55 candidates are selected annually.

- An average of at least 60%
- Mathematics 60%
- Physical Sciences 50%

Duration:

4 yr. academic
1 yr. community service

Bachelor of Occupational Therapy

50 candidates are selected annually.

- An average of at least 60%
- Mathematics 50%
- Life Sciences 50%

Duration:

4 yr. academic
1 yr. community service

Bachelor of Nursing

50 candidates are selected annually.

- An average of at least 60%
- Mathematics 40% OR Mathematical Literacy 70%
- Life Sciences 50%

1 yr. community service
