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The Department of Health will soon start vaccinating the general public.

In order to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, you must register on the EVDS Self-Registration System. Presently, the system is only open to people 60 years and older but will be opened up to other age groups in stages.

This guideline will take you through the process to register for a COVID-19 Vaccine.

Step 1- You need to go to the registration site.

The system will open at 16h00, on 16 April 2021.

- 6. Should a subsequent vaccination dose apply (based on the vaccine regimen in question), a follow up scheduling appointment SMS will follow.
