

**The Department of Health will soon start vaccinating the general public.**

In order to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, you must register on the EVDS Self-Registration System. Presently, the system is only open to people 60 years and older but will be opened up to other age groups in stages.

This guideline will take you through the process to register for a COVID-19 Vaccine.

**Step 1- You need to go to the registration site.**


The system will open at 16h00, on 16 April 2021.

You will also be asked if you are 60 years and above. At present, the system is only open to people who are 60 years and older.



Step 3 requires your cellphone number. It is very important that you enter the correct number, as this is the number that we will use to communicate with you. If you do not enter the correct number, you will not get the message indicating when and where you need to go for your vaccination.

## Step 4: Address details

For step 5, you will be given a choice as to where you will be vaccinated. You can choose to be vaccinated close to where you live, or you can choose to be vaccinated in a place of your preference.

You will be asked: Do you want to get vaccinated at a vaccination site close to where you live?

If you indicate yes, the system will automatically schedule you to a site close to where you live, based on the address data you entered.

If you indicate no, you will be able to indicate on the next screen, where you prefer to be vaccinated.

If in step 5, you indicated that you wanted to be vaccinated at a place of your preference, you will be taken to the screen above.


You will first have to indicate where you would prefer to be vaccinated, indicating province, municipality, city/town, and suburb.

You will then have to indicate if you want to be vaccinated on a weekday or weekend, and if you want to be vaccinated in the morning or afternoon.

### **Step 8 – What is next?**

1. You will receive an SMS on the cellphone number that you used for self-registration, confirming successful self-registration for vaccination.
2. You will also receive an SMS in the future, stipulating the place, date, and time of your scheduled vaccination appointment.
3. Please present for your vaccination at the place, date and time provided and please bring the identity document that you registered with for identity verification purposes.
4. The vaccination site will communicate the vaccination process on the day of the vaccination.
5. Following the successful completion of the vaccination dose, you will receive an SMS confirming vaccination status.
6. Should a subsequent vaccination dose apply (based on the vaccine regimen in question), a follow up scheduling appointment SMS will follow.
